January 11	Deadline to submit Admission Application for Residency purposes; Residency Questionnaire; Petition to Repeat; Over 19 Unit enrollment clearance - Overload; Prerequisite Clearance, or Prerequisite Challenge.
January 26	Registration and Waitlist close for Spring 2017 at 9:00 a.m.
January 27	Registration re-opens at 12:00 noon via Web Advisor for available classes
January 30	Spring Classes Begin
Jan 30- Feb 6	Late registration completed via Web Advisor-Add Permit Code required to register or add full-term courses.
February 6	Last day to ADD full-term classes. *For late start courses go to Web Advisor, enter any start date after February 6
February 6	Last day to park in student lots without a Parking Permit, with the exception of a Temporary Pass, good for 10 days.
February 6	Last day to drop full-term classes and qualify for refunds. Students enrolled beyond this date are financially responsible for their fees.
