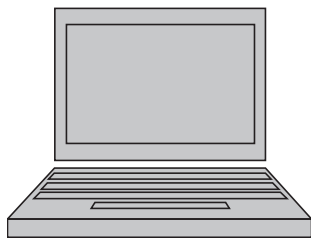
Early Childhood Education

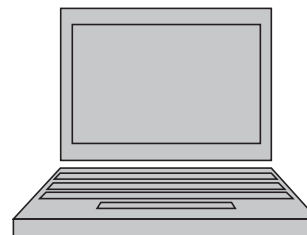
