Multi Criteria Selection Process Worksheet

Admission criteria to the ADN program has been changed to a multi-criteria screening and ranking as authorized by the California Community College Chancellor's office and the California Board of Registered Nursing. *Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements (GPA of at least 2.5 in the prerequisite science courses) before being considered for multiple criteria. [Although not required for application, a minimum TEAS score of 62% is necessary for final acceptance into the nursing program.]* Students are ranked using the following multi-criteria screening:
