- Checking for a new TMC and updating the TMC double count and elective units field on the form, verifying all of the information, and attach this document in CIM.
- The above changes will not require Chancellor's Office submission.
- All programs that are updated with these minimum CalGETC requirements with no other changes must be submitted as a list to the Chancellor's Office with the certification form and appropriate signatures by June 1, 2025.
