The Desert Community College District was successful in passing its Measure B Bond Measure on March 2, 2004 for \$346.5 million. Pursuant to ECS 15278, and Proposition 39 restrictions, the District is required to appoint an Oversight Committee whose primary purpose is to inform the public at least annually in written report concerning the expenditure of bond proceeds.

The Oversight Committee consists of at least seven members from specified groups or organizations. The memberships must have one member each from a business organization, a senior citizen organization, a community college support organization, a bona fide taxpayer organization, Member-At-Large East Valley, Member-At-Large West Valley, and one student from College of the Desert. Ms. Tish Lacy (Student Representative) term ends September 2015. The next student representative is recommended as follows:
