

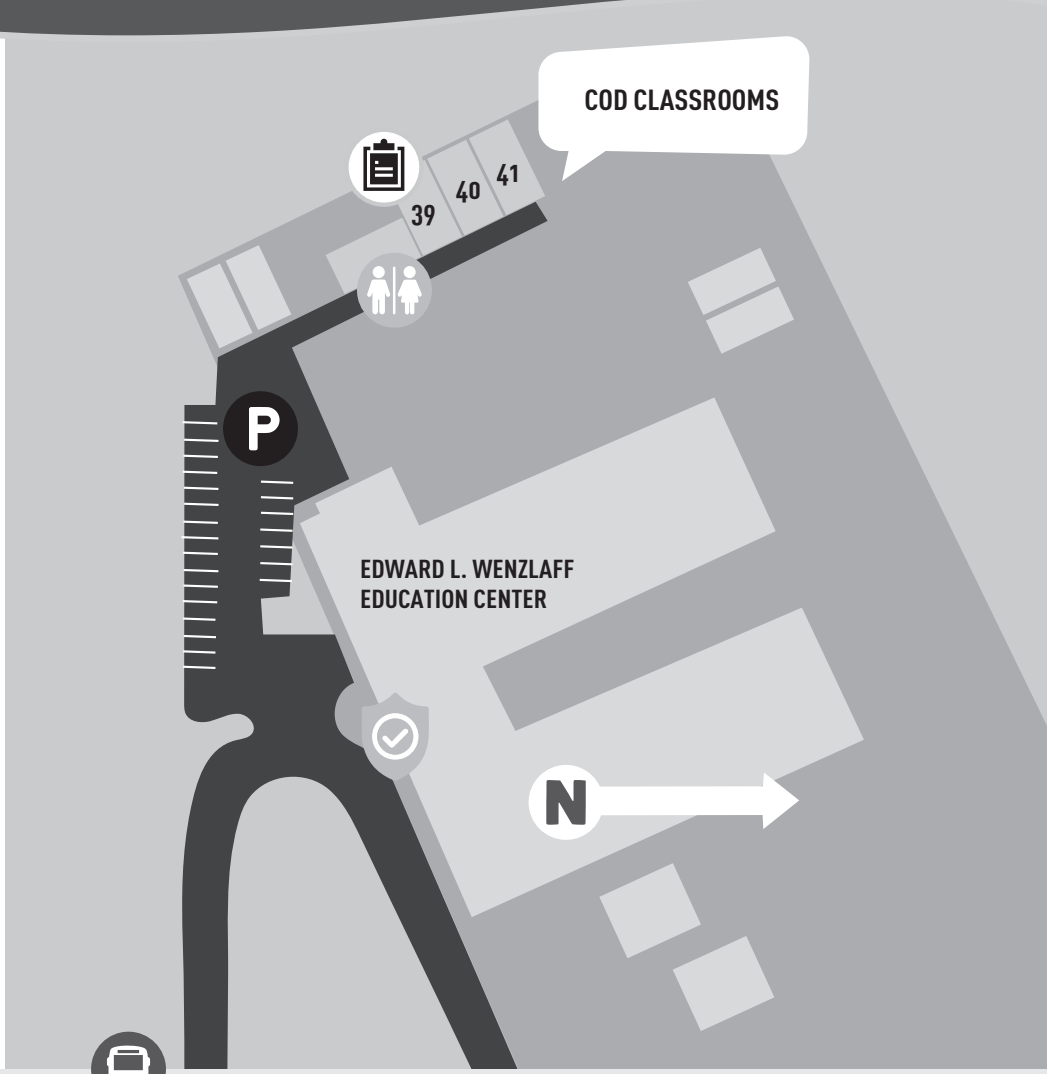

### English As A Second Language - Noncredit

**ESLN 309A** is the foundation course for ESL students who require basic skills development in reading, writing, speaking, and listening. Students receive a Pass/No Pass grade mark.

**ESLN 310A**, the Level I (low-beginning) ESL course, introduces students to basic structures of functional American English and stresses the simple present and present continuous tenses in reading, writing, listening and speaking. Prerequisite: ESLN 309A, or self-placement, or instructor recommendation. Students receive a Pass/No Pass grade mark.

**ESLN 310B**, the Level II high-beginning ESL course, reviews previously learned materials from Level 1 and helps to further develop students' abilities in reading, writing, speaking and listening focusing on simple past, and simple future. Prerequisite: ESLN 310A, or self-placement, or instructor recommendation. Students receive a Pass/No Pass grade mark.
