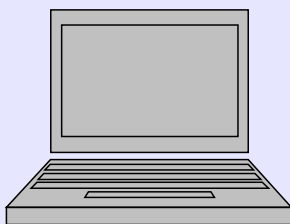
Interession Start and End Dates
